Position Description - Youth Worker

The Anglican Church of Noosa (ACN) has congregations at Sunshine Beach, Tewantin and Peregian. We are seeking a Youth Worker to reach young people in the Noosa district based in Peregian. This is a part-time position 2/3 days week including Friday or Saturday, and Sunday.

Our Vision is: Living to Love and Proclaim Jesus.

- -We are passionate about loving Jesus because he first loved us.
- -We are passionate about proclaiming Jesus, sharing the Good News.

Our Values are:

Christ-centred, Bible-based, Spirit-led, and Mission-shaped.

Role Summary

Our Youth Worker will be a person who loves young people and is passionate about helping them to encounter God through His Word and people. She or he will be able to teach and inspire young people to know and love Jesus.

Our Youth Worker may have significant training and experience or be just starting out in youth work. We are keen to work with the successful applicant to develop their skills and experience. We especially value theological training.

This person will work closely with the Peregian Church Minister to:

- Raise up joyful followers of Jesus.
- Identify, encourage and train prospective leaders from within the church.
- Build on our Breakfast Club (Bible Study for 10-16 year olds Sunday mornings during the 9.30am church service).
- Supplement and expand our occasional Friday or Saturday evening youth gatherings to become a flourishing Youth Group.
- Encourage youth participation from all three centres in the Parish.
- Plan and carry out fun, engaging youth gatherings that promote faith in Jesus and engagement with the Bible.

- Consider the transitions for children growing into Youth Group and teenagers growing into young adulthood.
- Be a leader with whom a variety of young people can connect.
- Be a spiritual role model and example of Jesus' love.
- Participate in wider ACN events (Peregian, Tewantin & Sunshine Beach).

Selection Criteria:

The successful applicant will

- Have an obvious love for Jesus and His people.
- Believe the Bible is the authoritative Word of God 2 Timothy 3:16,17.
- Have the qualities of 1 Timothy 3:8-13.
- Have a good grasp of the Gospel and be able to lead someone to Christ and disciple them in the scriptures.
- Be able to work with others, recruiting and encouraging volunteers in the team.
- Commit to the vision, values and mission of the Anglican Church of Noosa.
- Maintain the safe ministry practices of the Anglican Church Southern Queensland.

All ACN staff must hold a Blue Card, complete a National Police History Check, and uphold the standards outlined in the Anglican Church of Australia's Faithfulness in Service code of personal behaviour for church workers. All Diocesan procedures must be followed.

Remuneration taking into account training and experience will be offered in accord with the regulations of the Anglican Church Southern Queensland.
